ότι ή κόμη άντι περιβολαίου δέδοτσι

37 IAKONOY 2;22

και έκ των έργων ή πίστις έτελειώτη

4. POMAIOYE 12;5

παραστήσαι τά σώματα ύμων θυσίαν ζωσαν

5. IOANNHN 14;28

ότι ο πατήρ μείζων τού έστιν.

Each of the above phrases represents the sort of thing that happens when someone comes to you and says: "I wonder if you can tell me what something means in the Bible. It's just a few words and I can't seem....."

You may have a dedicated theologican with an axe to grind or you may have a truly concerned and confused Christian. You may have a cultist, in fact.

So for each of the above statements, offer an exegesis. Be sure to consider the context, etc. Note also those interesting items in Greek with which we have been working.
