Looking ahead to chapters 4-5

- Read the chapters at least twice...try to read them at least once along with the first three chapters.
- 2. What does the throne suggest? Why is there a rainbow present?
- 3. Think about the elders. Why are there 24 of them? What do they seem to represent? What is their chief function?
- 4. What are the living creatures? What is their role in the scene.
- 5. Compare the worship songs of chapters 4 and 5. What is the difference in content?
- 6. What is the book and why do you think it has seven seals?
- Study carefully the Lamb. Note its appearance and note what action it will take and why it has this right.

In some of these points a commentary on revelation will be helpful. A Bible dictionary would also be useful as well as a concordance.

VIEWPOINT ON THESE CHAPTERS

The view of this class is that of pre-tribulationism...a belief that the church will be removed from the earth before the time of universal judgment.
