

--Bible Crusaders

This body was more inclined towards political activity and was organized by G.W. Washburn. It concentrated on lobbying with state legislatures and worked particularly for anit-evolution bills. It was a forerunner, in some ways, of the more modern Moral Majority...which body could learn something from the history of these earlier groups, if it were so minded.

--The Research Science Bureau:

Concentration on the work of Harry Rimmer, presbyterian minister and outspoken fundamentalist, the Bureau published an important set of literary contributions under the title the John L. Frost Memorial Library. The big contest was against evolution, theistic evolution, and modernism.

--Christian Life Movements were those campaigns that sought to rally believers for a cause affecting the entire gamut of life. Among these were (are)

--The National Reform Association

A body committed to seeking readjustment of public policies that are hostile to Christian expression

--The Victorious Life Testimony

A group seeking to promote a more triumphant Christian witness.

In our modern community a parallel would be the Christian Action Counsels where serve more to rally Christians on the right-to-life issue and other pragmatic societal affairs.

In such groupings you would also find the WCTU, etc.

--The Association of Conservative Colleges (1924)

Primary purpose was the securing of non-evolutionary teaching as well as assistance in fund raising.

--The League of Evangelical Students

Formed in 1925-26, the body continues today but in a small way (as I see it). It had many prominent leaders in its original base including Abraham Kuyper, J.Gresham Machen, M.G. Kyle, H.P. Sloan, etc., with many leaders from abroad. The aim of the league was to reach university students and acquaint them with Christian truth and principles. It preceeded groups such as Inter-Varsity Christian Fellowship and Campus Crusade but essentially, in its time, did about the same work these groups seek to do.

--Bible Conferences
