- 1. The year is 1908...the place is Philadelphia...what great ecumenical event is happening there and how is it reflected in our church world today?
- 2. We have been bothered a lot by Church World Service...not that we don't think one should do some good for others. But what is our specific concern with this body?
- 3. Archbishop Soderblum is hard at work in Stockholm in 1925. What is he working on and what role will it later play in modern ecumenism?
- 4. Things show up in some of these courses that make you wonder..for example, how could a good move like the old German Pietism be a help to modern ecumenism? Please offer us some enlightenment.
- 5. We are keenly observing the present struggles in the Southern Baptist
 Convention. There is quite a structural difference between this body and
 the one we sometimes call the "northern convention." What is that difference
 and how is it affecting the commencial scene?
