V. **The Predictive Portions**      Zechariah 9-14

A. **Introductory Materials**

1. Explanatory note on the terminology:

Predictive items occur throughout Zechariah but it seems that the chief message of the first six chapters relates to the temple work while the message of the last six chapters relates to a future deliverance. The intermediate chapters look both ways, in solving a problem of the time and in giving guidance for the future. Our title, therefore, for these last six chapters is not strictly accurate, but with this general understanding we may hopefully live with it.

2. Structural arrangement of the section:

Following the divisions based on the Hebrew term "burden"                      we note these units:

---The burden of the oppressor, 9-11  
       enemies without 9:1-8  
       concepts of defense 9:9, 10:12  
       enemies within 11:1-17

---The burden of the oppressed, 12-14  
       enemies without 12:1-8  
       enemies within 12:9, 13:9  
       concepts of defense, 14

This is a bit artificial but not totally forced. The worst that can be said for it is that it is
