## I. Some general notes:

- -- They say the longer the title the duller the talk!
- -- The Work of the Lord...
  - -- The challenge of our time and the tests of discouragement.

It is more important for us to remember the help of God and to be filled with the possibility of what He will do. But in coming to this we need to bear in mind certain key ideas given by the Lord Jesus:

- -- The servant is not greater than his lord...
- -- If they have hated me....
- -- If they have rejected my word....
- -- I delight to do thy will....

- -- The Challenge in Zechariah's day... Build the Temple
  - -- the return
  - -- the job
  - --an interruption
  - --a resumption
  - -- the time table
  - --points of inference and interference as well.
