## GALATIANS

This is the fourth of the Soteriological letters and is a very clear statement of Christian faith..someone called it the "Magna Carta of Christian Liberty"..but I never seem to remember who it was that called it that. The idea is certainly sound.

I. Data

A. To whom did Paul write? Much of the rest of the related data is affected by this. I will try not to confuse you..but cannot promise that as the matter is involved in what is called the "northern/southern Galatian theories." The whole thing is occasioned by the difference in the ethnic territories (north) and the Roman province (south) and here is a summary of sorts:
