THE ASSIGNMENT FOR CLASS TWO IS:

1. Learn the Greek alphabet...how to say it and how to write it.
2. Spend at least one hour with your "buddy" reading the Greek on page 8...pronouncing it, criticising one another, and working on the alphabet.
3. Read over the syllabus material and note anything you do not understand.
4. Look over the text on page 8 and the breathing mark notes in the left column.

Remember: You must know the alphabet materials very thoroughly.

5. Memorize the vocabulary on page 7 and let this be your beginning in a strong foundation of Greek words.
