Notes

- /8/ (5:1-11) The third comparison finds Christ after the royal priesthood of Melchizedek. The comparison is one of degree and this shows the Lord's superiority to all human priests.
- 5-7 /9/ (5:12-6:20) The warning is to turn from Christ's leadership is catastrophic error and there is no recall.
- /10/ (7:1-8:13) The meaning is that to those who believe, there is a great high priest who administers a new covenant: He is all they need, all they should desire.

- /11/ (9:1-10:18) The fourth comparison shows Christ the fulfillment of the types of ceremony and sacrifice and so as the anti-type, superior to the type or prophecy.
- 9-10 /12/ (10:19-34) The warning summarizes the concept that, as He fulfilled this aspect of redemptive service, there is no hope outside His blessing.
- /13/ (10:35-39) The meaning is that we have assurance and confidence as we wait for the fuller revelation of His grace and power.

- /14/ (11:1-3) We are told that the essential ingredient in all ages has been faith..the willingness to believe and do what God has said.
- 11 /15/ (11:4-38) These examples demonstrate that faith is the working principle among all men and in all situations
- /16/ (11:39-40) The meaning is that we are given confidence and reassurance in the trust of God.

- 5 /17/ (12:1-24) We are advised of God's dealing with us in the place to which Christ has brought us and are advised as to how we should respond.
- 12-13 /18/ (12:25-29) We are warned that apart from this place is only judgment and condemnation
- /19/ (13:1-19) We are instructed that out of this we are to live lives of love, spiritual sacrifice, and holy service until the time when the "Great Shepherd" completes His will for us.
