FINALLY:

Remember these things:

If you have trouble with study at Biblical please see your counsellor or teacher as soon as possible. We love to help but cannot do it sometimes because we are unaware that some need is existing in a student's life.

If you cannot complete an assignment on time you should contact the instructor before that class and mention the circumstances to that party. In some cases the instructor may not be able to help..you may need a variance of some sort. But in many instances the instructor is glad to help and able to do so. Don't be hesitant to confer with those with whom you work.

If you think the work loads are too heavy you may discuss that as well with the teacher. But the problem may be in your study habits and the instructor may want to know just what you are doing in this area. On the other hand, once in awhile a teacher forgets how it was...and gets overly ambitious. Most of the faculty members at Biblical are sensitive to this sort of thing and will at least give you an honest hearing.

And if you have questions about a paper or a grade, conference on those issues is always welcome.

Above everything else, pray much about your work and progress. We believe that honest work and committed prayer are fundamental to success in most of these things.
