

- Keet, C.C. A Study of the Psalms of Ascents: A Critical and Exegetical Commentary on Psalms 120-134. London: Mitre, 1969.
- Kidner, Derek. Psalms 1-72, 73-150. Two Volumes. Tyndale Old Testament Commentary Series. Downers Grove, Ill: Intervarsity, 1973, 1975. Useful and practical. Often shows good insight.
- Kirkpatrick, A.F. The Book of Psalms. The Cambridge Bible for Schools and Colleges. Cambridge: Cambridge Press, 1910. A classic work. Not heavily detailed but comprehensive.
- Leupold, H.C. Exposition of the Psalms. Columbus: Wartburg Press, 1959. Thorough in the tradition of this commentator. Helpful.
- Lewis, C.S. Reflections on the Psalms. New York: Harcourt, Brace and World, 1958. Thoughts, exegetical, emotive, interpretive on the psalms. Not exhaustive but of real interest.
- McCann, J. Clinton. A Theological Introduction to the Book of Psalms. Nashville: Abingdon Press, 1993.
- Ferrowne, J.J. Stewart. Commentary on the Psalms. Grand Rapids: Zondervan, 1963. (reprint) An older work of considerable depth.
- Scroggie, W. Graham. Know Your Bible: The Psalms. London: Pickering and Inglis, 1951. In four volumes...simple but meaningful studies on all of the psalms. Very helpful
- Spurgeon, C.H. The Treasury of David. Grand Rapids: Zondervan, 1963 (reprint). A classic work but as it is very sermonic it is often wordy and long. Good homiletical value.
- Thirtle, James William. The Titles of the Psalms: Their Nature and Meaning Explained. London: Froude, 1904. A very significant work in the study of the superscriptions. Technical.
- Weiser, Arthur. The Psalms: A Commentary. Tr. Herman Hartwell. Philadelphia: Westminster, 1962. Not very helpful to me but...
