- (1) Subject *The Shepherd Psalm*
- (2) Questions
- (3) Interpretation analysis
- (4) Pastoral Point: The worshipper is dependent upon and delights in the care of God.
- (5) Application

This is one of the happiest of the psalms.. a favorite Scripture of many persons.. just note that it is centered on the Lord and that will give you a key as to how our relationships with Him are most significant.

c. Psalm 91

- (1) Subject *absolute security*
- (2) Reading the psalm: What things are striking to you in the reading of this work?
- (3) Questions
- (4) Interpretation analysis: There are some tough points in this with regard to absolutes, personal promises, etc.
- (5) Pastoral point: The worshipper is dependent upon and delights in the Lord's person.
