

- (4) Can we distinguish the aspects (advents) of Messianic ministry in the Psalms?
  - g. Among historic aspects of interpretation, note a tendency among the church fathers (Justin, in particular) to find Messianic meaning in every corner of the psalms.
2. Psalm 2..The Royal character.
- a. Subject: "God's King" (Jensen)  
Note Jensen's analytical note on page 21.
  - b. Literary notes:
    - (1) stanza development:
      - 1-3, the heathen
      - 4-6, God's reaction
      - 7-9, the decree
      - 10-12, the spiritual advice

Unlike many of the psalms, the stanzas are almost alike in length and form of lines.
    - (2) Parallelisms:
      - vss 1-5
      - vss 8-9
      - vs. 10
    - (3) speech figures of special interest
      - vs. 9
      - vs. 12
    - (4) note the order and nature of speakers in the psalm. Notice in particular who speaks to whom and what each has to say
    - (5) and we will note the textual problem and suggestions offered in verse 12.
