- d. Ps. 45....the eternal nature of the throne (see Hebrews 1:8-9)
- e. Psalm 61
- f. Ps. 72....the extent of Messianic rule
- g. Ps. 89....the anointing (see Acts 13:22)
- h. Psalm 110...as in ps. 2. But note that 110:1 is the most widely quoted O.T. verse in the New Testament. You can look 'em up!
- i. Ps. 132....the promise of rule (Acts 2:30)
- j. Ps. 144....the power and authority of the king.

A lot more may be said of these and I can only hope you will have the time and opportunity to study them in fuller detail some time in your future.

4. Psalm 22. The personal character

The psalms in this category talk more of the Messiah in the "man" role. These are more graphic to us in the knowledge of what Christ has done and the nature of His passion.
