- m. 132....v. 13 (the longest of the lot)
- n. 133....v. 1
- o. 134....v. l (the shortest)

it is inevitable but what I will make a few notes on these..but only a few. Some of the most forceful expressions in the psalter are given in the verses I have mentioned.

- 3. Compendium of thoughts...and one will notice how much of the thinking in the Psalms of Degrees centers in these areas:
 - a. The significance of Jerusalem
 - b. The reality of Divine help
 - c. The assurance that those who depend are secure
 - d. The joy of being part of the people of God.
- H. Some Miscellanaeous Psalm notations:
 - The Acrostic of Alphabet psalms
 - a. These are psalms in which the stanze contruction is arranged in alphabetic sequence.

 While they do not all follow the same pattern they all have a sequence in which the verses are enumerated on an alphabetic sequence in the psalm. The psalms that do this are:

119

9-10 utilize the whole alphabet together

while the other psalms use it complete in each.

b. The reasons for this arrangement system are unknown!
