

- 2:10.. רַעֲמֵי "comrade" remember it is rooted in רַעַה and takes on particular meaning to fit the context.  
 ... Note "fair one" and see the idiomatic way the action is set in the final clause.
- 2:11.. הַקִּי "winter" 711 (the)  
 ... גִּשְׁמִים "rain"..the verbs seem redundant but emphasize the action of the verse.
- 2:12.. נִצְנִים "blossoms" 665  
 ... זָמִיר "singing" you will see the root of the term מִזְמִיר that occurs in the Psalms.  
 ... תּוֹר "turtle dove"
- 2:13.. תְּאֵנָה "fig tree"  
 ... קָנַט "make spicy" 334.."embalm" is also suggested but that hardly fits the context at this point.  
 ... בְּצִיָּה "early figs" 803  
 ... סְמִדָּר "grape blossoms" 701  
 ...I will note, just in passing, that verses like 9 and 13 almost make one want to quit Hebrew forever, but don't do it.
- 2:14.. יוֹצֵי "dove" and we have seen it already a few times.  
 ... חֲסוּיִם "concealed places" 291  
 ... קֵלַע "cliff"  
 ... מִדְּרָה "steep places" 201  
 ... עֵרֶב "sweet" 787  
 ...And watch "comely"...this is the third time or so we have seen it.
- 2:15.. שׁוּמְאִים "fox" 1043...here is one of the great speech figures.  
 ... חָבַו "spoil" "destroy"  
 ... סְמִדָּר "grape blossoms" as in vs. 13
- 2:16..Perhaps the best known verse in the book...watch "lillies"
- 2:17.. צִלְצִיִּים "shadows" 853  
 ... בֵּתֶר Proper name Bether or perhaps a word for cliff 144  
 I hope you will not allow the difficulty of the Hebrew to keep you from seeing the beauty of a life enjoyed together as set forth in this chapter.
