

In coming to chapter 5...I may not repeat words of low occurrence that have already been given...and, again, I may. Generally it depends on how I feel when I come on the word! Terms for "bride", "garden", etc. have occurred and are generally in your vocabulary range. So if something is omitted that should have been noticed, probably I did it on purpose.

5:1... אָגַד "gather" 71, 4 times!

...Watch myrrh and spices!

... חֶמֶד "honeycomb"

...Note the pluralized form for beloved. This use of majestic significance is very common in these "conceit" chapters.

5:2... אֶחָד "undefiled one" ("complete one")

... טֶהֱוֵה "dew"

... קְלוֹצוֹתַי "locks of hair"

5:3... שָׁטַף "put off, strip" 833

... כִּתְּוֵה "tunic" "cloak" 509

... שָׁטַף "defile" h.l. 380

...And אֵיךְ is more literally, "How-thus" the question following.

5:4... חֹר "hole" 359

... חֵטִי "inward parts" somehow belly seems crude 588

... הִחִה "murmur"

5:5... נִטַּף "drip"

... אֶצְבָּצְבָּי "fingers" from אֶצְבָּ 840.

... כַּפְּוֵה "handles" but same root at "palm" or "sole" 497:4:e

... חֲנִטָּה "bolt" 653

5:6... חָמַק used only twice, I think, "turned away."

5:7... שָׁטַף "bruise" 822 used about three times

... רָדִי "large veil" 921..used twice. It is very hard to get an exact meaning for a word of low frequency.

5:8... חָלָה "sick" a word from the second year lists!

5:9...And I believe there is nothing in this verse for which you need my help but note the nature of the questions and get ready for a complicated vocabulary response.
