In coming to chapter 5... I may not repeat words of low occurrence that have already been given..and, again, I may. Generally it depends on how I feel when I come on the word! Terms for "bride", "garden", etc. have occurred and are generally in your vocabulary range. So if something is omitted that should have been noticed, probably I did it on purpose.
