Galatians 3:19-29, 4:4-7

A. Introduction:

- 1. The Galatian letter..a work of deep emotion and solid theology as Paul reaches out to meet the need of the fellowship and protect it from false teachers.
- 2. The text in view:
 - a. The problem: some are leaving the faith teaching and returning to works for being right with God
 - Both law and works are put into a proper perspective for the health and grwoth of believers.
- B. Discussion: Three propositions help us to put the meaning of the text into perspective.
 - 1. The law was given that we might understand our hopelessness:
 - a. Defining "law"..Historically the Mosaic covenant. Practically any declaration of the will of God.

 - d. keeping us under judgment 23
