### I. Some Introductory Notes

### A. The Character of these talks

These messages are being presented during a week of spiritual life emphasis. They do not attempt to answer all the questions of Christian living but they do seek to suggest some spiritual truths that keep us "alive" in the face of situations that may prompt spiritual declension. The passage from Timothy is used in view of the challenge that he faced to build churches of spiritual character in a very hard place. Our thought is that the message used to produce spiritual vitality in should certainly help in the challenges we face today. Our points taken from these verses will hopefully speak both to the heart and to the head that growth might be the real answer to the problem of maintaining spiritual life.
