ments of faith, but in their polluted condition no longer do them service, and, indeed, even talk about changing them and standardizing them to bring them up to date. This is the circumstance in our day and age and the action which was called for in Calvin's time is no less demanded today. Separation is demanded and absolute shunning from all thit is sacriligious and perversive of the work of Christ and the apostles. John Calvin's view of the Separatist Church is the view which is held in the 20th Century Reformation Movement today. It is compatible with Historic Christianity as well as being instituted and taught by the Holy Word of God.
