So there are several places where the 70 years of Tyre's being forgotten would fit in -- several places. But it is hard to know where there is any place that her goods being used to sustain the Lord's people could fit in -- hard to know of any place. as I said yesterday, you hate to qualify it all the time. There's lot's we don't know. But there is hardly any place where you can see her goods being used for the Lord's people. Therefore, on the strength of that most prophecy scholars have looked at it and said, Well, it rather has to be future. And so then again we have said, Well, why is Tyre -- the same problem with Tyre as we mentioned yesterday with Assyria. Why is Tyre mentioned by name? And several members of our class mentioned that it might be the name of the place, it might be get its name from the local. It might be that it happens to be a name given then rather than calling it whatever it is called today. It might be any one of those particular circumstances. But this along with the Egyptian prophecy is what I call a pretty clear cut example of prediction unfulfilled. Now, we said yesterday, if some of us are prone to drop them all into the Kingdom Age, where we may drop some of them after a bit, but Tyre as far as a political force is concerned has been nothing since the days of Alexander.
