Otherwise the bulk of mission work was the building of monasteries in remote places and seeking to propagate the faith from them. This age was one of such confusion in direction and orientation that we should not be surprised that the church became rather wrapped up in itself and not in outreach.

Summary

For this period be sure you understand the progression of the growth of the Roman church, the relationships that developed along national lines and the chief aims of the Scholastics, reformers and mystics. Have a grip as well on the particular problems that vexed the church and, as is usual, on what we might be able to say about them.
