

(3) The Student Volunteer Movement

(4) The International Missionary Council

(5) The Bible Conference Movement (and the allied prophetic conference movement)

(6) The Church Council (for want of a better term) groupings.

(7) The Faith Missions...this is more difficult since it can properly belong to this bracket or to that which is to come. I put it here for, while the missions were often seen as parachurch works, their downplay of church distinctives was a key factor in their acceptability to many groups:

(a) the idea

(b) the implementation

(c) field arrangements

Inter-denominational works have the plus factor of bringing more work strength to bear on an individual project but, unfortunately, tend to weaken the individual forces standing behind the work. It is hard to find the middle ground between exclusivism and inclusivism but that is the position that must be sought and should be findable in the light of these works.
