A. Background Material

- 1. Roman Civilization
 - a. The governmental ideal: a system of checks and balances with this arrangement:
 - (1) the oligarchy
 - (2) the army
 - (3) the dictator or tyrant
 - (4) the populus
 - (5) the minor officials
 - (6) the citizenry

On paper the ideas seemed great..but they did not always work as well as they appeared..but it did give a continuing controlled society that lasted in essence over a thousand years.

- b. the society
 - (1) languages: the trilingual setting
 - (2) commonality in community
 - (3) economics of a slave state
 - (4) education: reading and schools
- c. the religious idealogy
 - --a highly developed form of polytheism... mythological concepts at their worst, I think..but not taken seriously. Emperor worship is a much more serious thing and it is in this area where the church has its most serious tests.
