

- Leo of Rome: one of the most important bishops of Rome throughout its history: theologian, leader, etc...authored the famed "Tome" that set the pace for Chalcedon.
- John of Damascus: Author of a systematic theology in the fashion of that day.."The Fountain of Knowledge"..decisive in the Second Nicene Counsel..posthumously decisive, that is.
- John Chrysostom: Famed preacher of Constantinople and leader in the grammatical/historical interpretation mode. Fearless in his denunciation of sin in higher places.

- 6. Things to remember in the study of the Fathers:
 - a. Each is to be studied in the light of his time...
 - b. Each to be studied in view of the problems current...
 - None to be evaluated on the basis of later knowledge.
