discontinuation of the Friday fast changes in clerical garb removal of the Vulgate as the official text vernacular Bible translations purging of the list of saints communion in both kinds deemphasis on auricular confession indulgence reform limitations on the Index, etc.

Some of these are minor and there are others I have failed to mention. The church has permitted the charismative movement within it..and in fact some of the leaders have been Romanists. Rome always allowed the healing gifts (Lourdes, you know) and now permits some Bible study almost of an independent sort. But the fruits of liberalism are increasingly tolerated in the Roman communion and that does not augur for good.

The church's long standing policy on birth control and clerical celbacy are still enforced although there is a lot of argument about them. A number of conservative Roman cells have also developed where priests and nuns have avowed to maintain the "old ways". Social changes in many countries have cost the church its prestige and the admission of divergent religious ideals have done a lot to injure the catholic oneness appeal in places such as Spain.

It is an interesting scent to watch and to watch in the hope of snatching some of the brands from the burning.

VI.2.f Church Growth Thrust

Charismatic movements

Movements oriented to charismatic expressions occur on a cyclic pattern in the church. At the same time there is always a fringe but I mean that at times the fringe becomes the major move. We have seen such a wave in the last 25 years. It has been prominent in America and Europe and is accompanied often (but not always) with stress on success, popularity, wealth, etc.
