4:30....He will not forsake you..nor forget the covenant that had been made with the fathers and is still in force!

## SPIRITUAL EXPERIENCES OF MOSES AND THE PEOPLE

### I. Introduction

Greetings in the Lord's Name as we contnue in our study of the book of Deuteronomy, the fifth book of the Bible.
