v. 3....the meat v. 4....Produce, beverage, wool

18:6....a sojourning Levite from a distant place

18:7....ministers as an equal with the locals

18:8....and all participate alike

18:9-14. Warnings against compromise with false worship in the land

v. 9....purity to be the rule
v. 10...no participant in pagan rites
v. 11...no one familiar with the dead (necromancy)
v. 12...these practices have all been judged and condemned by the Lord and should not be found among His people..instead...

18:13....You will be "perfect" (Matthew 5)

18:14....You will respect the Lord your God in all things
