

the requirements of God in salvation..the thing that is required is faith in the Lord Jesus. But in terms of relvance in daily life what is necessary is that the student learn to distinguish:

eternal.....	temporal matters
universal.....	local
spiritual.....	physical
omnipersonal.....	individual.

That which is described by the right hand column does not apply directly to us. That given in the left hand column does although it will need to be studied for the relevance of each item.

Now when we say it does not apply directly we mean the carrying out of the particular matter is not ours.

6. Behind law is principle and this is our great concern in Bible study. If we can discern the principle in operation it will enable us to know how to apply and how to learn lessons from all parts of the law and the rest of the Bible as well.
7. We will stop therefore and ask ourselves what the underlying principles are behind some parts of the law. And we will just do it in class to stimulate thought and probably to promote confusion.

V. The Institution of Worship 25:1 -40:38

This is another section on deliverance..deliverance from self and false worship. The concept of redemption by blood and power comes into our worship practices as well as our daily living. The whole person is touched by redemption.

Worship is being "formalized" in these chapters with the tabernacle" and the priesthood. The development is normal as with any thing that grows. It is a matter of revelation, however, not a human development on needed sociological lines.

A. The Tabernacle 25-27, 35-38.
