

6. The reissuing of the law 34

- a. the promise 34:1-3
- b. the covenant renewed 4-17
- c. stipulations for blessing 18-28
- d. Moses reports to the people.

The careful student will try to keep the historical narrative firmly in mind while adding the worship sections.

In this portion there is great emphasis on righteousness, forgiveness, judgment, and intercession. It is a serious section which should command our attention in respect to how our lives are lived. It should also remind us that there is no sin which grace cannot overcome when God's people call on Him

Moses stands as an example for all of us and we will remember the words of Hebrews 2..he was faithful in all his house.

E. The completion of the worship projects 35-40

We will not spend a lot of time in this..unless we have a lot all at once for it is largely repetitive of the instruction section. The principle outline goes like this:

1. The building of the tabernacle 35-38

Of special interest is the tabulation of what was given in chapter 38.

2. The making of the priestly garments 39

3. The setting up of the tabernacle..40

Note how the cloud comes to the place and signifies the continuity of Israel's place in the sight of God.
