- 3. The letter Waw is presently pronounced "vav" although undoubtedly the ancient way of saying it was with the bilabial. I will probably never get over this so be prepared.
- The letter Tau is presently pronounced Tav and the same concept applies as is mentioned above.
- 5. The gutterals are all hard in Hebrew and they are: Aleph X



- Ayin
- 6. The letters Aleph, **X** He, **n** Heth, **n** Ayin **y** and Resh may not be doubled.
- And here are some lines of Hebrew to run through just naming the letters. I know we have not had much time to learn them so read with me and enjoy yourself.
