

6. On this word development, note the following which are all taken from the word **כָּתַב** "he wrote"

כְּתִיבָה "a writing"

מְכַתֵּב "a letter" (note mem)

כְּתוּב "a document"

כְּתוּב יָד "a manuscript"

כְּתוּבַת "an address"

מְכַתֵּבָה "a desk"

כְּתוּב "a spelling"

So work hard on the vocabularies...Hebrew is very repetitive in them and if you know a few words well you know a lot of words slightly!
