VIII. LESSON SEVEN: Hebrew Grammatical Features of Interest

Just to keep you posted, we have studied the Hebrew alphabet, Hebrew words, verb and noun principles and have picked up a little vocabulary as we have gone. Much of this is for recognition...I have mentioned all that I think you must know.

In This Class, we will try to:

- 1. Pick up some points on pronouns
- Take a squint at the Hebrew prepositions of major importance
- Get a glimpse of some of the major particles... and anything else that strikes us on the way.

For your Next Assignment:

- Read Hebrew aloud either from work in the syllabus or from a Hebrew Bible for one hour. Time yourself. You may take a break if needed but put in a good hour being as consistent as you possible can.
- Return to page 21 and spot at least ten words that have inseparable prepositions. Copy 'em out.. tell what the preposition is. Identify its meaning, that is.
- 3. Return to the Hebrew on page 11. Read it over and make a list of all the words you can identify as 1) nouns 2) verbs 3) prepositions 4) pronouns. (Items 3 and 4 should be independent prepositions and pronouns, not those that are attached to another word) Spend about 1/2 hour on this....no more..and be ready to turn it and item 2 in for the appraisal of the skilled eye of the teacher.
- Learn the new vocabulary...and it is always a good idea to review the old.
