The Major Hebrew Tools

In the paragraphs that follow there will probably be a lot of stuff not totally clear but I will try to break it into reasonable segments. The fact is that you are not going to use many of the major tools unless you get into Hebrew but, for the moment, you need to know what they are and how you can proceed with them. I have arranged the material in the order of usefulness to us, as I see it.

1. The Concordances:

Although in English, the following two concordances show Hebrew and Greek roots and are very useful tools:

--YOUNG'S ANALYTICAL CONCORDANCE...it show the English translation or the English word found in the text. Then it shows the Hebrew characters and a transliteration.
