Similarly the classical appeal of Matthew 11:1 and the question of John the Baptist.

Note the percentage of these in the first four chapters. We will probably review the purpose of prediction and how the fulfillment certifies the fact that God has spoken and emphasizes the reality of what He has said and the veracity of His spokesmen.

B. The King and His Subjects: The Sermon on the Mount 5-7

 - j. How can we determine if one is working or living in a proper way or not?
