Now in one way or another an outline is an outline but the intent of them all is to organize the material and thinking that goes with it into a logical arrangement that will enhance the knowledge and understanding of the student or the hearer. You should aim, if you have not done so, to know a basic outline for every book in the Bible..not one of great detail but one that will make the content of the book more available to you and to anyone to whom you might have opportunity of ministry.
