F. Observations and conclusion:

In just noticing these parallels we are able to suggest the following important items:

1. Each Gospel has its own character

4. The repetitive concept is to be honored as a means of showing the universality of the truth
5. Small additions or deletions in particular sequential material simply indicates the adoption of the lesson for varied settings.
