TRUTH CONCERNING THE CHARACTER OF THE LORD'S PEOPLE

<u>Their State</u> (characteristic)	<u>Their condition</u> (when)	<u>Their promise</u> (why)
<u>they are blessed</u> (3-12)	poor in spirit -3 mourning -4 meek -5 hungering** 6 merciful -7 pure in heart -8 peacemakers -9 persecuted ** 10 reviled *** 11	theirs the kingdom of heaven they shall be comforted theirs...the earth they shall be filled they shall receive mercy they shall see God be called God's children theirs the kingdom of heaven they have great reward
<u>they are useful</u> (14-16)	salting -13 lighting -14 honoring -15	it is their purpose it is their mission they are glorifying God.
they are taught well (17-20)	honoring the word -17 keeping the word -18 doing the word -19	it is eternal the key to usefulness means of true righteousness
