Whybray, R.N. THE MAKING OF THE PENTATEUCH..suggests a single author but somewhere in the 5th-6th century!

The commentary material on the subject is voluminous. Likewise the feature articles in various religious encyclopedias are useful, particularly those in the 9th edition of the Encyclopedia Britannica (historic value in the expression of critical ideas). The student should keep eyes open for used copies of the RAINBOW BIBLE by Paul Haupt, et al, in which the different authorial touches are indicated with separate colors. That was a little much for most critics but is a nice memento of the process.
