4. Pentateuch usage in the Gospels.

Basically the Pentateuch is used in the Gospels to illustrate truth and to argue for correct doctrinal expressions. You will need to read backward from these N.T. verses to the Pentateuch but it should not be that hard!

--John 1:3 --John 3:14 --John 6:31 --Matthew 23:35 --Matthew 10:15 --Mark 12:26 --Luke 17:26, 28

5. Pentateuch usage in the Book of Acts

--Acts 3:13 --Acts 3:33 --Acts 7:1-44 --Acts 13:17-18

These and other passages are used to argue for the veracity of God's dealing with Israel and the authentic ministry of the Apostolic age.

6. Pentateuch usage in the Epistles

--Romans 10:5 --1 Corinthians 9:9 --Galatians 3:24 --Hebrews 9:19

One will need to do a careful study of the word "law" in the New Testament. "Law" as a saving principle is neither a New Testament nor an Old Testament concept. "Law" as a guide to the character of God and the reality of His love, is a concept of both testaments.

7. Revelation usage of the Pentateuch

--Rev. 5, among others..the whole concept of the sacrificial lamb is Pentateuchal.
