4. Purposes in prophecy and prediction

- a. Immediate purpose: to inform the people of God for a particular action at a particular time.
- b. To convict in matters of sin, disobedience.
- c. To demonstrate the reality of God's control
- d. To instruct in even the most basic pursuits
- e. To authenticate a messenger beforehand
- f. To explain the character and dealings of God with His people.
- g. To show how the life of God's people is to fulfill the concepts of truth expressed in His law.
