

--While Kings tends to tell more of the northern kingdom, Chronicles deals most with the southern. Can you see why from our first note above.

b. Ezra

--about 454...the return of another group to Palestine from Persia.

--the great theme is the restoration of spiritual life in Jerusalem.

c. Nehemiah

--the return for the building of the wall. With Ezra a great revival is accomplished.

--The practicality of this book is very pronounced. Contemporary with Ezra...but the two men are very different sorts of men.

d. Daniel

--A great book of prophecy and committed Christian living.

--The messages of Daniel have a great deal of historical verification today.

That is about all we can say. The readings in Archer will make up for our deficit and out time work. But this is just introductory material. You will need to fill out the content in other classes and in your own work. Remember: your goal is to have an efficient working knowledge of all of the Bible.
