C. The Mechanics of the Course

1. Assignments: There are two categories of assignments..the first group constitutes the weekly (?) assignments and the second group the "standing" or quarter assignments. This is essentially a Bible elective and there is no required text but the Bible and the particular parts assigned for special reading and translation. Read the notes in BDB or a standard Hebrew Lexicon on JDD. Remember that all written reports should be typed..double spaced. The dictionaries (encyclopaediae) are in the Library if you do not have them otherwise. The most current edition of ISBE is preferred.
