a. We learn about ourselves:

- (1) our need
- (2) God's availability
- (3) The conditions of worship
- (4) The results: practical and theoretical

b. And we pick up some spiritual lessons:

- (1) The place and need of worship
- (2) The requirement of voluntary service
- (3) The fact that the weakness of our human nature is no excuse for a failure to love God
- (4) The greatness of God's care
- (5) The effectiveness of the blood

c. And we gain some practical lessons in:

- (1) fellowship
- (2) dedication
- (3) avoiding sinful conflicts
- (4) thankfulness

B. Mechanics in worship:

1. The environment:

- a. Tabernacle, temple
- b. The worshipful devices: altar, etc.

2. Accompanying worship aids:

- a. instruments (music)
- b. choir
- c. liturgies (suggested identification)

3. And the people:

- a. those who encourage worship
- b. those who supervise the acts of worship
