OT523 Old Testament Survey

General survey, emphasizing the content and groupings of the materials of the Old Testament. Four hours.

Assignments:

Reading: The Old Testament...one complete reading in connection with this course.

OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY, Jensen. The parts should be read concurrent with our discussions.

Writing: There are five writing projects and they are as follow:

1. Prepare a ground plan of Israel's tabernacle establishment using only the Bible for your work. You may compare it with something else when you are finished.
2. Prepare a map detailing the conquest of Palestine and the areas settled by the tribes. You will probably need to consult another source for this.
3. Prepare an annotated outline of the life and work of David.
4. Read and prepare a two page report on Dr. Newman's book: THE EVIDENCE OF PROPHECY.
5. Study the use of the Old Testament in the Sermon on the Mount and prepare a short paper (3-5 pages) on how the Old Testament is here used.
