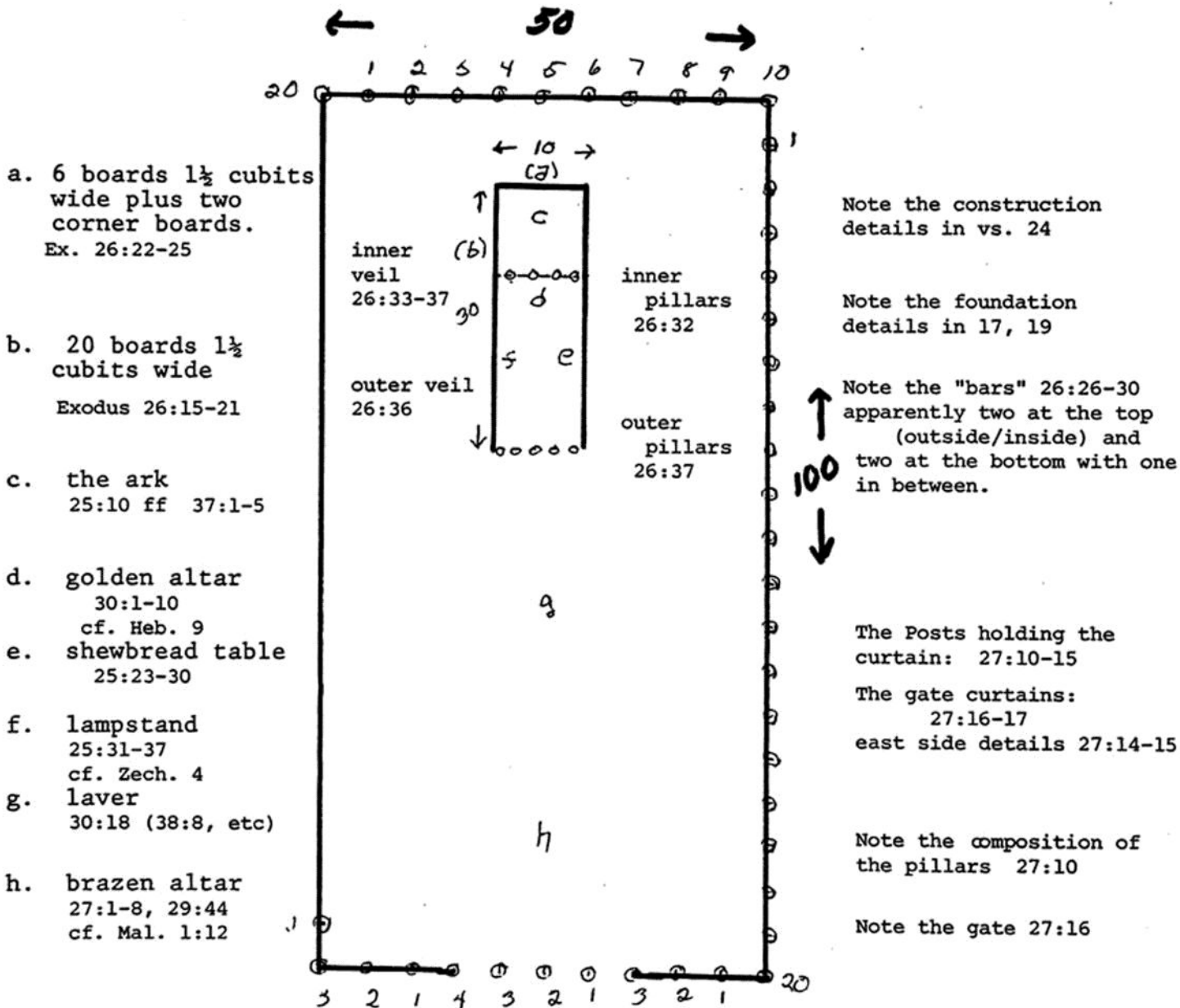


Old Testament Survey

Taylor fumbles with the Tabernacle

(The Tabernacle should be square on the page..not whopperjawed... but when you have a wriggly T-square...)



All three entrances are marked with the same texture.. "blue, purple, scarlet, and "fine twined linen." 26:31, 37, 28:16. The curtain or hanging going around the general area is just "fine twined linen" 27:9.

Note we are not given any description of the roof! The key to the building procedure is in 25:9. Note the coverings in chapter 26...note especially the inner curtain. There are four of them altogether. Symbolism abounds in everybody's interpretation. We will not tip our hand but we think it no accident that the means of approach to God is by a singular door, past the place of substitution (sacrifice), through the water of cleansing and unto the place of propitiation. Spiritual lessons abound.
