1-Paul, one bound for Jesus Christ, and Timothy, the brother, to the well-beloved and our fellow worker, Philemon, and to sister Aphia and to our fellow-soldier Archippus and to the church at your house. Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

I thank my God at all times when making mention of you by my prayers, hearing the love which you have towards all the saints and the faith which you have toward the Lord Jesus, that the fellowship of your faith may become activated in the precise knowledge of every good thing among us unto Christ. For I have great joy and comfort by means of your love; because the bowels of the saints are refreshed through you, brother. Wherefore, having real boldness in Christ to command that which is fitting to you, on account of love I prefer to exhort, as much as I. Paul, am an aged man but also at this very time am one bound for Jesus Christ. I exhort you concerning my child, whom I have begotten in bonds, Onesimus, one who was once to you unprofitable but is now profitable to you and also to me, whom I have sent unto you, himself, the one who is my bowels. 13
