

a servant, a beloved brother, dearest to me but rather how much
 more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord.¹⁷ If then you
 have me as a partner, receive him as myself.¹⁸ But if he has
 wronged you or owes you anything, charge that to me.¹⁹ I Paul
 have written by my own hand, I will repay.²⁰ So I do not tell
 you that you owe to me besides this yourself. Yea, brother,

may I have joy of you in the Lord: refresh my bowels in Christ.

I have written to you being fully persuaded by your goodness,
 knowing that you will do above that which I say.²² But beyond this
 prepare for me a quarter for I hope that through your prayers
 I shall be given to you.²³ Epaphras salutes you, he who is my
 fellow-soldier in Christ Jesus, Mark, Aristarchus, Demas, Luke,
 my fellow workers.²⁴
