MESSAGE #1. OUR DECLARATION

Biblical Passages: Acts 2:22-36; 4:1-12; 17:1-4; 26:13-18

I. Introducing the Subject:

The term "practical" refers to the working nature of the Lines laid down in the Word of God for areas of our fellowship and living. It differs from "theoretical" in which we hypothesize that something should work or should not. Based on its own statements and claims, we declare that the Bible is the infallible rule of faith and practice. We make it the ground on which our other structures are built. Within this declaration there are a number of things that are given to us authoritatively. they are taught to us by the Word and in accepting the Word we accept and announce them.
